- 2 I would go for the repairable model even if it costs a little more.

put back

devolver a su lugar

- 1 Put the item back if you decide not to buy it.
- 2 She put the cereal back after comparing the ingredients.

set aside

reservar

- 1 The shop set the last pair aside for me.
 - 2 Could you set this lamp aside until this afternoon?

- 1 The concert shirts sold out before noon.
- 2 The limited-edition notebooks sold out online in an hour.

mark down

rebajar

- 1 The store marked the winter coats down by thirty percent.
- 2 They marked the display model down because of a small scratch.

go up

subir de precio

- 1 Delivery fees went up at the start of the month.
- 2 The price of imported olive oil has gone up again.

come down

bajar de precio

- 1 Fresh berry prices usually come down in season.
- 2 Tablet prices often come down when a newer model arrives.

- 1 The store swapped the scratched shelf out for a new one.
- 2 They swapped the faulty charger out without charging a fee.

get back

recuperar el dinero

- 1 It took three days to get the refund back.
- 2 You should get the deposit back within five working days.
