- 1 I need to go back to the office.
- 2 She went back for the passport she had forgotten.

- 1 Do not go by the headline alone.
- 2 We go by the figures in the signed report.

go against

oponerse o contradecir

inseparable · B2

- 1 The decision goes against our policy.
- 2 He went against the advice of his legal team.

go without

inseparable · B1

- 1 We had to go without internet for a day.
- 2 The hikers went without hot food during the storm.

go for

elegir

inseparable · B1

- 1 I think I will go for the earlier flight.
- 2 We went for the simpler design in the end.
