- 1 We found a way to work around the software limitation.
- 2 The kitchen worked around the missing ingredient.

work off

eliminar mediante actividad

separable · B1

- 1 We walked home to work off the large meal.
- 2 He worked the nervous energy off at the gym.

work over

interrogar o golpear

separable · C1

- 1 The gang worked the witness over for information.
- 2 This violent sense is mostly found in crime stories: they worked him over.
