celebrar o suscribir

1 The companies entered into a five-year distribution agreement.

2 Neither party may enter into a competing agreement during the term.

spell out

detallar explícitamente

1 The schedule spells out each party's reporting duties.

2 The annex spells the payment milestones out in detail.

sign off on

aprobar formalmente

1 Both legal teams signed off on the revised clause.

2 The board must sign off on any settlement above the stated threshold.

back out of

retirarse de

1 The buyer tried to back out of the transaction.

2 A termination fee applies if either party backs out of the deal.

hold up

demorar

- 1 A disclosure dispute held the proceedings up for several weeks.
 - 2 The missing disclosure held the closing up until Monday.

- 1 The appellate court handed down its judgment on Friday.
- 2 The court handed a unanimous decision down.

abide by

acatar

- 1 Both parties must abide by the court order.
- 2 The licensee agreed to abide by the revised compliance conditions.
