 - 2 Maya took her wet jacket off near the entrance.

put away

guardar

- 1 Please put the groceries away after breakfast.
 - 2 The children put their games away before dinner.
- Conexión: 2 contextos · 2 sentidos

hang up

colgar

- 1 Hang your coat up in the hall.
- 2 I hung the clean apron up beside the pantry.

 - 2 Everyone helped clean the balcony up after the plants were moved.

wipe down

limpiar una superficie

- 1 Wipe the kitchen counters down after cooking.
- 2 He wiped the dining table down with a damp cloth.

sweep up

recoger barriendo

- 1 I swept the crumbs up after dinner.
- 2 Could you sweep the spilled soil up by the window?

wash out

lavar el interior

- 1 Wash the recycling bin out before using it again.
- 2 She washed the storage box out in the sink.

sort out

clasificar

- 1 We sorted the laundry out by color.
 - 2 We sorted the old clothes out for donation and repair.
- Conexión: 8 contextos · 3 sentidos

put on

colocar

- 1 Put a clean pillowcase on before making the bed.
 - 2 He put a fresh cover on the guest-room duvet.
- Conexión: 4 contextos · 3 sentidos

hang out

tender

- 1 They hung the sheets out on the balcony.
- 2 I hung the damp shirts out where they could dry in the sun.

fold up

doblar

- 1 Fold the dry towels up and place them on the shelf.
- 2 She folded the spare blanket up before storing it.

calentar

- 1 I warmed the leftovers up for lunch.
 - 2 Warm the soup up slowly so it does not boil over.

clear away

retirar

- 1 We cleared the breakfast dishes away.
 - 2 They cleared the tools away once the shelf was secure.
- Conexión: 2 contextos · 2 sentidos

throw out

desechar

- 1 Do not throw the glass jars out; we can reuse them.
- 2 We threw the broken sponge out and opened a new one.

use up

terminar o agotar

- 1 We used the open carton of milk up before buying another.
- 2 This recipe uses the leftover rice up without wasting it.

 - 2 It took the family a few weeks to settle into the new apartment.

lie down

recostarse

- 1 I lay down for twenty minutes after cleaning.
- 2 He lay down on the sofa while the floor dried.

stay up

quedarse despierto

- 1 We stayed up to finish assembling the shelves.
- 2 The neighbors stayed up late to finish painting the hallway.

sleep in

dormir hasta tarde

- 1 I sleep in on Sundays when the house is quiet.
- 2 Guests can sleep in while we prepare breakfast downstairs.
