work out

calcular o resolver

- 1 We worked out the total cost of the trip.
 - 2 Can you work out how long the transfer between terminals takes?
- Conexión: 2 contextos · 2 sentidos

set aside

reservar

- 1 Set aside some money for local transport.
- 2 We set an afternoon aside to explore the old town on foot.

head out

salir

- 1 We headed out before sunrise.
- 2 Let us head out early so we miss the city traffic.

subir a un transporte

- 1 Get on the train at platform four.
- 2 We got on the airport bus outside the arrivals hall.

get off

bajarse

- 1 We got off at the wrong stop.
- 2 Get off at the next station and follow the signs for Terminal B.

pick up

recoger

- 1 The shuttle picked us up at the hotel.
 - 2 A local guide picked us up outside the cruise terminal.
- Conexión: 3 contextos · 3 sentidos

drop off

dejar en un lugar

- 1 The driver dropped us off near the museum.
 - 2 Could the taxi drop me off at the international departures entrance?
- Conexión: 2 contextos · 2 sentidos

registrarse

- 1 We checked in online the night before.
 - 2 Passengers without checked bags can check in through the airline app.
- Conexión: 4 contextos · 4 sentidos

fill out

completar un formulario

- 1 Fill out the customs form in advance.
 - 2 Each traveler filled the arrival card out before landing.
- Conexión: 2 contextos · 2 sentidos

get through

pasar un control

- 1 It took an hour to get through security.
- 2 Families with small children were able to get through security quickly.

take off

despegar

- 1 The plane took off on time.
- 2 Our flight took off forty minutes after the scheduled departure.

touch down

aterrizar

- 1 We touched down in Bogotá at noon.
- 2 The aircraft touched down safely despite the heavy rain.

registrarse en el hotel

- 1 Guests can check in after three.
 - 2 We checked in at the hotel and left our passports in the safe.
- Conexión: 4 contextos · 4 sentidos

check out

dejar el hotel

- 1 We checked out before breakfast.
- 2 You must check out by eleven, but the hotel can store your bags.

settle in

instalarse

- 1 It took us an hour to settle in.
- 2 After settling in, we walked around the neighborhood.

retrasar

- 1 A storm held up several flights.
- 2 A technical inspection held our departure up for nearly an hour.

break down

averiarse

- 1 Our rental car broke down outside the city.
 - 2 The tour bus broke down halfway up the mountain.
- Conexión: 3 contextos · 3 sentidos

run out of

quedarse sin

- 1 We ran out of fuel on a rural road.
- 2 We nearly ran out of cash on the island because the ATM was closed.

turn back

regresar

- 1 We had to turn back because of the snow.
- 2 The hikers turned back when the weather became unsafe.
